- Where you have provided us with credit or debit card details for payment, this will NOT at any time, be held on file.

Systems and Training

- We are committed to critically reviewing our systems and procedures on an ongoing basis and have an established team of competent staff members, who continually scrutinise the way we operate.
- All team members are regularly briefed in the importance of data safety.
- Our management team is fully engaged and committed to follow advice and guidance provided by the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) and sets exceptional data safety standards for the organisation.
